# SHORT TERMS STAY OF FOREIGN RESEARCHERS

#### Objective and eligibility

The <u>KIM Data & Life Sciences</u> offers financial support for hosting foreign guest researchers in research units partners of the MUSE I-Site for **short stays** (between 2 and 3 months).

The funding concerns researchers or professors in a foreign institution, recognized for their scientific excellence in the development of new data analysis methods. As part of their hosting, guests will be expected to contribute, through the development or application of new methods, to the KIM themes. All fields of biology are covered by this call for project.

Applicants must have obtained their doctoral degree more than 10 years ago. Preference will be given to applicants who have not lived nor conducted their main activity (academic career, research program...) in France for more than 12 months during the three years preceding the date of submission of the application.

Proposed projects must clearly indicate the objective of the stay and its added value for Montpellier's research teams (implementation and transfer of concepts and innovative methods, setting up a partnership project, joint response to a call for projects...). The hosted researcher will participate in the work of the host laboratory and must give at least one seminar for the KIM Data & Life Sciences.

#### Amounts allocated and funding modalities

The stays within this call for projects shall take place between May and November 2022.

The KIM Data funding will cover transport costs of the researcher as well as accommodation (*per diem*) of **2000€-3000€ per month** (depending on the length of stay).

#### Please note:

- The KIM will organize transport travel for the visiting researcher (travel between home town and Montpellier).
- The KIM will book directly accommodation for the visiting researcher **or** pay him a *per diem* at the end of the visit upon presentation of supporting documents for expenses incurred for accommodation.

Applications will be considered on a rolling basis and the result will be communicated to the applicant no later than <u>a month</u> from the date of submission of his project.

Projects submissions must be sent by a research unit of the MUSE I-Site, and signed both by the host scientist and by the director of the research unit.
